- 2 relating to the physician licensing requirements for foreign

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 155.0031(c) and (d), Occupations Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Applicants for a license must subscribe to an oath [in
- 8 writing before an officer authorized by law to administer oaths].
- 9 The written oath is part of the application.
- 10 (d) An applicant must present proof satisfactory to the
- 11 board that:
- 12 (1) each medical school attended by the applicant is
- 13 substantially equivalent to a Texas medical school as determined by
- 14 board rule; or
- 15 (2) the applicant is specialty board certified by a
- 16 specialty board organization acceptable to the board.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 155.004, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 155.004. ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR
- 20 GRADUATES OF CERTAIN FOREIGN MEDICAL SCHOOLS. A license applicant
- 21 who is a graduate of a medical school that is located outside the
- 22 United States and Canada must present proof satisfactory to the
- 23 board that the applicant:
- 24 (1) is a graduate of a school whose curriculum meets

- 1 the requirements for an unapproved medical school as determined by
- 2 a committee of experts selected by the Texas Higher Education
- 3 Coordinating Board;
- 4 (2) has successfully completed:
- 5 <u>(A)</u> at least three years of graduate medical
- 6 training in the United States or Canada that was approved by the
- 7 board; or
- 8 <u>(B) at least two years of graduate medical</u>
- 9 training in the United States or Canada that was approved by the
- 10 board and at least one year of graduate medical training outside the
- 11 United States or Canada that was approved for advanced standing by a
- 12 specialty board organization approved by the board;
- 13 (3) [is eligible for a license to practice medicine in
- 14 the country in which the school is located, except for any
- 15 citizenship requirements;
- 16  $\left[\frac{(4)}{(4)}\right]$  holds a valid certificate issued by the
- 17 Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates; and
- (4)  $[\frac{(5)}{}]$  is able to communicate in English.
- 19 SECTION 3. Sections 155.0031 and 155.004, Occupations Code,
- 20 as amended by this Act, apply only to an application for a license
- 21 filed with the applicable licensing authority on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act. An application for a license filed
- 23 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 24 effect on the date the application was filed, and that law is
- 25 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
