**IN RE: HB1656** by Guillen (Relating to the authority of certain municipalities and counties to regulate platting requirements near an international border.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would affect Nueces County and counties located within 50 miles of the Texas-Mexico border relating to authority to regulate plats and issue certificates for utility connections.
