IN RE: SB328 by Carona (Relating to the civil and criminal consequences of operating a motor vehicle or a watercraft while intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Alcoholic Beverage Code, Chapter 106 and Transportation Code, Chapter 524 to include the operation of a watercraft while intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol to the driver license suspension statutes related to driving under the influence by a minor. The bill would take effect on September 1, 2009.

The Department of Public Safety anticipates no significant fiscal impact to the agency.
