Amend CSHB 6 (house committee report) as follows:

- (1) Strike page 39, line 23, through page 40, line 16, and substitute the following:
- Sec. 31.102. TITLE AND CUSTODY. (a) Each <u>instructional</u> material [textbook] purchased as provided by this chapter <u>for a school district or an open-enrollment charter school</u> is the property of <u>the district or school</u> [this state].
- (b) Subsection (a) applies to  $[\frac{an}{a}]$  electronic  $\frac{instructional}{instructional}$   $\frac{material}{agreement}$  only to the extent of any applicable licensing
- (c) The board of trustees of a school district or the governing body of an open-enrollment charter school [is the legal custodian of textbooks purchased as provided by this chapter for the district or school. The board of trustees] shall distribute printed instructional material [textbooks] to students in the manner that the board or governing body determines is most effective and economical.
- (2) Strike page 42, line 24, through page 43, line 6, and substitute the following:
- (c) [Each textbook must state that the textbook is the property of or is licensed to this state, as appropriate. Each textbook, other than an electronic textbook or a printed copy of an open-source textbook, must be covered by the student under the direction of the teacher.] Except as provided by Subsection (g), a student must return all <u>instructional materials</u> [textbooks] to the teacher at the end of the school year or when the student withdraws from school.
