(b) A person commits an offense if the person engages in or 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 solicits the transportation of household goods for compensation and is not registered as required by Subchapter B.

1-17 (e) An offense under Subsection (b) is Class C а misdemeanor, except that the offense is: 1-18

(1) a Class B misdemeanor if the person has previously been convicted one time of an offense under Subsection (b); and (2) a Class A misdemeanor if the person has previously 1-19 1-20 1-21

been convicted two or more times of an offense under Subsection (b) 1-22 1-23 [punishable by a fine of not less than \$200 or more than \$1,000 per violation]. 1-24

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 1-25 1**-**26 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 1-27 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 1-28 1-29 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 1-30 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. SECTION 3.
