No. 4 (house committee report) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: SECTION ____. Subchapter G, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2166.3031 to read as follows: Sec. 2166.3031. UNIFORM PURCHASING CONDITION. (a) In this section: (1) "Manufactured goods" means an item produced as a result of the manufacturing process. "Manufacturing process" means the application of (2) a process to alter the form or function of the materials or elements of a product in a manner that adds value to the product and transforms the materials or elements into an end product that is functionally distinct from an end product produced merely from assembling the materials or elements into a product. (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the uniform general conditions for a construction project, including a project authorized to receive funding under Section 15.433, Water Code, in which iron, steel, or manufactured goods will be used must require that the bid documents provided to all bidders and the contract include a requirement that the iron, steel, and manufactured goods used in the project be produced in the United States. (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a project for which the governing body of the governmental entity responsible for the project determines that:

27 (1) iron, steel, or specific manufactured goods are

28 not produced in the United States in sufficient and reasonably
