5	ARTICLE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE TEXAS ETHICS COMMISSION TO
6	THE TEXAS COMPLIANCE COMMISSION
7	SECTION01. The heading to Chapter 571, Government
8	Code, is amended to read as follows:
9	CHAPTER 571. TEXAS COMPLIANCE [ETHICS] COMMISSION
10	SECTION02. Section 571.002(1), Government Code, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	(1) "Commission" means the Texas Compliance [Ethics]
13	Commission.
14	SECTION03. Subchapter A, Chapter 571, Government Code,
15	is amended by adding Section 571.003 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 571.003. REFERENCE TO TEXAS ETHICS COMMISSION. A
17	reference in law to the Texas Ethics Commission means the Texas
18	Compliance Commission.
19	SECTION04. (a) Effective January 1, 2014:
20	(1) the name of the Texas Ethics Commission is changed
21	to the Texas Compliance Commission, and all powers, duties, rights,
22	and obligations of the Texas Ethics Commission are the powers,
23	duties, rights, and obligations of the Texas Compliance Commission;
24	(2) a member of the Texas Ethics Commission is a member
25	of the Texas Compliance Commission; and
26	(3) any appropriation to the Texas Ethics Commission
27	is an appropriation to the Texas Compliance Commission.
28	(b) Effective January 1, 2014, a reference in law to the
29	Texas Ethics Commission is a reference to the Texas Compliance

- 2 (c) The Texas Compliance Commission is the successor to the
- 3 Texas Ethics Commission in all respects. All personnel, equipment,
- 4 data, documents, facilities, contracts, items, other property,
- 5 rules, decisions, and proceedings of or involving the Texas Ethics
- 6 Commission are unaffected by the change in the name of the agency.
- 7 (d) The Texas Ethics Commission shall adopt a timetable for
- 8 phasing in the change of the agency's name so as to minimize the
- 9 fiscal impact of the name change. Until January 1, 2014, to allow
- 10 for phasing in the change of the agency's name and in accordance
- 11 with the timetable established as required by this section, the
- 12 agency may perform any act authorized by law for the Texas Ethics
- 13 Commission as the Texas Ethics Commission or as the Texas
- 14 Compliance Commission. Any act of the Texas Ethics Commission
- 15 acting as the Texas Compliance Commission on or after the effective
- 16 date of this Act and before January 1, 2014, is an act of the Texas
- 17 Ethics Commission.
