8	(a) The railroad commission has exclusive original
9	jurisdiction over the rates and services of a gas utility:
10	(1) that distributes natural gas or synthetic natural
11	gas in:
12	(A) areas outside a municipality; [and]
13	(B) areas inside a municipality that surrenders
14	its jurisdiction to the railroad commission under Section 103.003;
15	and
16	(C) an integrated rate area established under
17	Subsection (c); and
18	(2) that transmits, transports, delivers, or sells
19	natural gas or synthetic natural gas to a gas utility that

- 2 established on the date the gas utility files notice of the area's
- 3 establishment with the railroad commission. The notice must define
- 4 the boundaries of the integrated rate area and identify each
- 5 municipality included in the area. The gas utility must deliver a
- 6 copy of the notice to each municipality included in the area.
- 7 (d) A notice of intent to increase rates filed under Section
- 8 104.103 does not constitute notice under Subsection (c).
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 103.001, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- Sec. 103.001. MUNICIPAL JURISDICTION. To provide fair,
- 12 just, and reasonable rates and adequate and efficient services, the
- 13 governing body of a municipality has exclusive original
- 14 jurisdiction over the rates, operations, and services of a gas
- 15 utility within the municipality, subject to the limitations imposed
- 16 by this subtitle, unless:
- 17 (1) the municipality surrenders its jurisdiction to
- 18 the railroad commission under Section 103.003; or
- 19 (2) the municipality is included in an integrated rate
- 20 area established under Section 102.001(c).
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
