- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 67.0052, Water Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (a) To be listed on the ballot as a candidate for a
- 10 director's position, a person must file an application with the
- 11 corporation that includes:
- 12 (1) the director's position sought, including any
- 13 position number or other distinguishing number;
- 14 (2) if the corporation has 1,500 or more members or
- 15 shareholders, a petition $[\tau]$ signed by [the lesser of] 20 members or
- 16 shareholders [or five percent of the members or shareholders,
- 17 requesting that the person's name be placed on the ballot as a
- 18 candidate for that position;
- 19 (3) the person's written consent to serve, if elected;
- 20 (4) biographical information about the person; and
- 21 (5) a statement of the person's qualifications,
- 22 including a statement that the person has the qualifications
- 23 prescribed by Section 67.0051.
- 24 (b) The application must be filed with the corporation not

- 1 later than the 45th day before the date of the annual meeting. The
- 2 corporation shall notify the members or shareholders of the
- 3 application deadline not later than the 30th day before the
- 4 deadline.
- 5 (d) This section applies only to a corporation that provides
- 6 retail water or sewer service.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 67.0053, Water Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 9 (c) This section:
- 10 (1) applies only to a corporation that provides retail
- 11 water or sewer service; and
- 12 (2) does not apply to an election in relation to a
- 13 candidate for a director's position for which the board has adopted
- 14 a resolution under Section 67.0055.
- SECTION 3. Section 67.0054, Water Code, is amended by
- 16 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 (c) For each director's position, the candidate who
- 19 receives the highest number of votes or who is the subject of a
- 20 resolution described by Section 67.0055 is elected.
- 21 (g) This section applies only to a corporation that provides
- 22 <u>retail water or sewer service.</u>
- SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended
- 24 by adding Section 67.0055 to read as follows:
- Sec. 67.0055. ELECTION OF UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE. (a) This
- 26 section applies only to an election for a director's position on a
- 27 board of a corporation that provides retail water or sewer service

- 1 in which a candidate who is to appear on the ballot for the position
- 2 is unopposed.
- 3 (b) The board by resolution may declare a candidate elected
- 4 to a director's position if the board certifies in writing that the
- 5 candidate is unopposed for the position. A copy of the resolution
- 6 shall be posted at the corporation's main office.
- 7 (c) If a declaration is made under Subsection (b), the
- 8 election for that position is not held.
- 9 (d) If the election for the unopposed candidate would have
- 10 been held with an annual meeting of the members or shareholders of
- 11 the corporation, the text of the declaration described by
- 12 Subsection (b) shall be read into the record at the annual meeting.
- 13 (e) The ballots used at a separate election that is held at
- 14 the same time as an election for an unopposed candidate would have
- 15 been held shall include after measures or contested races the
- 16 position and name of a candidate declared elected under this
- 17 section, under the heading "Unopposed Candidates Declared
- 18 Elected."
- 19 <u>(f) A person may not, by intimidation or by means of</u>
- 20 coercion, influence or attempt to influence a person to withdraw as
- 21 a candidate or not to file an application for a place on the ballot
- 22 so that an election may be canceled.
- 23 <u>(g) The board may adopt necessary rules or bylaws to</u>
- 24 implement this section, including rules or bylaws to ensure the
- 25 fairness, integrity, and openness of the process.
- 26 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 67.007, Water Code, is
- 27 amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 67.007. ANNUAL OR SPECIAL MEETING OF RETAIL
- 2 CORPORATION.
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 67.007, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 4 Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 5 (e) This section applies only to a corporation that provides
- 6 <u>retail water or sewer service.</u>
- 7 SECTION 7. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Section 67.0075 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 67.0075. ANNUAL OR SPECIAL MEETING OF OTHER
- 10 CORPORATION. A corporation to which Section 67.007 does not apply
- 11 shall comply with the annual meeting and director election
- 12 provisions prescribed by Chapter 22, Business Organizations Code.
- 13 SECTION 8. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an annual or special meeting or a director election held on or
- 15 after the 75th day after the effective date of this Act. A meeting
- 16 or an election held before the 75th day after the effective date of
- 17 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the meeting or
- 18 election was held, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
- 20 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
