## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the eligibility requirements for plumbing licenses
- 3 issued to applicants with military service.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1301, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1301.3585 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1301.3585. APPLICANT WITH MILITARY SERVICE. (a) In
- 8 this section, "military" means the armed forces of the United
- 9 States, Texas National Guard, or Texas State Guard.
- 10 (b) The board shall credit relevant experience, training,
- 11 or education in plumbing that an applicant received while serving
- 12 <u>in the military toward the requirements for a license issued under</u>
- 13 this chapter.
- 14 <u>(c)</u> The board shall adopt rules necessary to implement this
- 15 section.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) Section 1301.3585, Occupations Code, as
- 17 added by this Act, applies only to an application for a license
- 18 filed on or after May 1, 2014. An application for a license filed
- 19 before May 1, 2014, is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 20 application was filed, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 (b) The Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners shall adopt
- 23 rules under Section 1301.3585, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 24 Act, not later than March 1, 2014.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
