- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 358, Acts of the 82nd
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2. BOUNDARIES. The Near Northside Management District
- 8 initially includes all the territory contained in the following
- 9 area:
- 10 In Harris County, Texas, the territory enclosed by Loop 610 as the
- 11 north boundary, Lockwood Dr. as the east boundary, Buffalo Bayou
- $12 \quad [\frac{\text{Interstate } 10}{\text{Interstate } 10}]$ as the south boundary, and Jensen Dr. as the west
- 13 boundary.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 15 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 16 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 17 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 18 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 19 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 20 Government Code.
- 21 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 22 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 23 Environmental Quality.
- 24 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed

- 1 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
- 2 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 3 within the required time.
- 4 (d) The general law relating to consent by political
- 5 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation,
- 6 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those
- 7 districts has been complied with.
- 8 (e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 9 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 10 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
- 11 fulfilled and accomplished.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
