A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to motor vehicle inspection requirements for vehicles
- 3 equipped with compressed natural gas containers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 548.104(d), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) An inspection station or inspector may not issue an
- 8 inspection certificate for a vehicle equipped with:
- 9 (1) a carburetion device permitting the use of
- 10 liquefied gas alone or interchangeably with another fuel, unless a
- 11 valid liquefied gas tax decal issued by the comptroller is attached
- 12 to the lower right-hand corner of the front windshield of the
- 13 vehicle on the passenger side; [or]
- 14 (2) a sunscreening device prohibited by Section
- 15 547.613, except that the department by rule shall provide
- 16 procedures for issuance of an inspection certificate for a vehicle
- 17 exempt under Section 547.613(c); or
- 18 (3) a compressed natural gas container unless the
- 19 <u>owner demonstrates in accordance with department rules proof:</u>
- 20 <u>(A) that:</u>
- (i) the container has met the inspection
- 22 requirements under 49 C.F.R. Section 571.304; and
- 23 (ii) the manufacturer's recommended service
- 24 life for the container, as stated on the container label required by

- 1 49 C.F.R. Section 571.304, has not expired; or
- 2 (B) that the vehicle is a fleet vehicle for which
- 3 the fleet operator employs a technician certified to inspect the
- 4 container.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2014, the
- 6 Department of Public Safety shall adopt rules relating to the proof
- 7 required by Section 548.104(d), Transportation Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act.
- 9 (b) The change in law made by Section 548.104(d),
- 10 Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a
- 11 vehicle inspected on or after September 1, 2014.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
