- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 397.0125(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In addition to the penalty provided by Section 397.012,
- 8 a person who operates an automotive wrecking and salvage yard in
- 9 violation of this chapter is liable for a civil penalty of not less
- 10 than \$500 or more than  $$5,000 \ [\$1,000]$  for each violation. A
- 11 separate penalty may be imposed for each day a continuing violation
- 12 occurs.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a violation of Chapter 397, Transportation Code, that occurs on
- 15 or after the effective date of this Act. A violation of that
- 16 chapter that occurred before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect when the violation occurred, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
