

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment to eliminate an obsolete  
2 requirement for a State Medical Education Board and a State Medical  
3 Education Fund.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 50a, Article III, Texas Constitution, is  
6 repealed.

7 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.  
9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment eliminating an  
11 obsolete requirement for a State Medical Education Board and a  
12 State Medical Education Fund, neither of which is operational."
