1-20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 50a, Article III, Texas Constitution, is  
1-22 repealed.

1-23 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
1-24 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.  
1-25 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
1-26 proposition: "The constitutional amendment eliminating an  
1-27 obsolete requirement for a State Medical Education Board and a  
1-28 State Medical Education Fund, neither of which is operational."
