- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 32.01, Tax Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) A tax lien on inventory, furniture, equipment, or other
- 7 personal property is a lien in solido and attaches to all inventory,
- 8 furniture, equipment, and other personal property that the property
- 9 owner owns on January 1 of the year the lien attaches or that the
- 10 property owner subsequently acquires, irrespective of whether the
- 11 personal property is located within the boundaries of the taxing
- 12 <u>unit in whose favor the lien attaches</u>.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
