IN RE: HJR79 by Branch (Proposing a constitutional amendment to repeal the constitutional provision requiring the creation of a State Medical Education Board and the establishment of a State Medical Education Fund.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$108,921.

The joint resolution would repeal the constitutional provision requiring the creation of a State Medical Education Board and the establishment of a State Medical Education Fund.
