Relating to the sunset review of the board of trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

HB 829 Thompson, Senfronia

Relating to the governor's executive authority while traveling outside of the state.

Relating to standards for power lines.

HB 1071 Allen

Relating to the use of state institutions of higher education to provide training to state agency employees.

HJR 42 Larson
Proposing a constitutional amendment to limit the time that a person may serve as a member of the Texas Legislature or as a statewide elected officer in the executive branch.

HJR 71 Thompson, Senfronia
Proposing a constitutional amendment to provide that the governor, and the lieutenant governor when acting as governor, retain executive authority unless unavailable as provided by law.

HJR 73 Larson
Proposing a constitutional amendment providing that a member of the legislature or person holding a statewide elective office automatically vacates office on announcing a candidacy or becoming a candidate for another elective office before December 1 of the last full odd-numbered year of the person's term of office.
