Relating to the substitution by a pharmacist of certain opioid analgesic drugs.

Relating to county expenditures for certain health care services.

SB 913 Lucio
Relating to the reexamination of an applicant for a professional counselor license.

SB 1013 Taylor
Relating to the administration of an immunization or vaccination by a pharmacist.

SB 1079 Duncan
Relating to the regulation of medical radiologic technology; providing penalties; imposing fees.

SB 1099 Zaffirini
Relating to the use of certain designations by a physical therapist.

SB 1106 Schwertner
Relating to the use of maximum allowable cost lists under a Medicaid managed care pharmacy benefit plan.

SB 1130 Schwertner
Relating to the temporary licensing of a dentist who performs voluntary charity care.

SB 1150 Hinojosa
Relating to a provider protection plan that ensures efficiency and reduces administrative burdens on providers participating in a Medicaid managed care model or arrangement.

SB 1175 Deuell
Relating to the establishment of a reuse program for durable medical equipment provided to recipients under the Medicaid program.

SB 1177 Deuell
Relating to the designation of ST segment elevation myocardial infarction facilities.

SB 1402 Carona
Relating to access to records and certain information in those records regarding a child placed for adoption.

SB 1610 Schwertner
Relating to the notification of individuals following a breach of security of computerized data.

SCR 26 Hinojosa
Designating November as COPD Awareness Month for a 10-year period beginning in 2013, and directing the Texas Department of State Health Services to include COPD as a chronic health condition in their public awareness and educational efforts.
