A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 2811

1 AN ACT

2 relating to proclamations issued by the State Board of Education

- 3 for instructional materials.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.002, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subdivision (1-b) to read as follows:
- 7 (1-b) "Proclamation" means a request for production of
- 8 new instructional materials issued by the State Board of Education.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 31.022, Education Code, is amended by
- 10 adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) and amending Subsection (f) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (b-1) Proclamations may be issued only during the second
- 13 year of a biennium. For any biennium, the board may only issue
- 14 proclamations for instructional materials in which the total
- 15 projected cost of instructional materials under the proclamations
- 16 does not exceed 75 percent of the total amount used to fund the
- 17 <u>instructional materials allotment under Section 31.0211 for that</u>
- 18 <u>biennium.</u>
- 19 (b-2) The board shall issue a proclamation for only
- 20 supplemental instructional materials instead of a proclamation for
- 21 instructional materials that are not supplemental if the
- 22 supplemental instructional materials are sufficient for the
- 23 subject addressed in the proclamation.
- 24 (f) The board shall amend any proclamation [request for

- 1 production] issued for the purchase of instructional materials to
- 2 conform to the instructional materials funding levels provided by
- 3 the General Appropriations Act for the year of implementation and
- 4 to comply with Subsection (b-1).
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
