1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the creation of a campus of the Texas State Technical  
1-20 College System in Ellis County.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 135.02(a), Education Code, is amended to  
1-23 read as follows:

1-24 (a) The Texas State Technical College System is composed of:

1-25 (1) a system office located in the city of Waco in  
1-26 McLennan County;

1-27 (2) a campus located in the city of Harlingen in  
1-28 Cameron County;

1-29 (3) a campus serving West Texas that operates as a  
1-30 collective unit of strategically positioned permanent locations in  
1-31 the city of Sweetwater in Nolan County, the city of Abilene in  
1-32 Taylor County, the city of Brownwood in Brown County, and the city  
1-33 of Breckenridge in Stephens County;

1-34 (4) a campus located in the city of Marshall in  
1-35 Harrison County;

1-36 (5) a campus located in the city of Waco in McLennan  
1-37 County;

1-38 (6) a campus [~~an extension center~~] located in the city  
1-39 of Red Oak in Ellis County; and

1-40 (7) campuses assigned to the system from time to time  
1-41 by specific legislative Act.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
