**IN RE:** SB392 by Burton (Relating to posting notice of a meeting of a governmental body on the Internet instead of in a newspaper.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would allow a governmental entity required to post notice of a meeting in a newspaper to instead post notice on the Internet. A governmental body required to post notice of a meeting on the Internet would not be required to post notice in a newspaper.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
