IN RE: SB1552 by West (Relating to additional functions of a commission panel of a municipal building and standards commission.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to amend the functions of a commission panel of a municipal building and standards commission to include the ability to order an action to be taken to remedy violations of ordinances relating to animal care and control or water conservation measures.
