Relating to information and services for foster children who are pregnant or minor parents.

Relating to appointment of a nonparent as managing conservator of a child.

HB 1449 Thompson, Senfronia
Relating to child custody evaluations and adoption evaluations conducted and testimony provided in certain suits affecting the parent-child relationship; providing penalties; creating an offense; authorizing fees.

HB 1480 Thompson, Senfronia
Relating to the definitions of dating violence and family violence for purposes of the issuance of a protective order.

HB 1500 Thompson, Senfronia
Relating to certain temporary orders in a suit for modification of an order in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship.

HB 2053 Farney
Relating to the protection of certain children who may be subject to child abuse or neglect through the operation of the child safety check alert list.

HB 2429 Vo
Relating to the persons who may consent to the medical care or immunization of a child.

HB 2616 Dutton
Relating to procedures related to juvenile justice proceedings; increasing the punishment for certain delinquent conduct.

HB 2751 Guillen
Relating to the composition of the juvenile board of Atascosa County.

HB 3121 Thompson, Senfronia
Relating to the enforcement of orders in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship.
