A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a report of child abuse or neglect made by an employee
3 of a school district or an open-enrollment charter school.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 38.004(a), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) The agency shall develop a policy governing the reports of child abuse or neglect, including reports related to the 8 trafficking of a child under Section 20A.02(a)(5), (6), (7), or 9 (8), Penal Code, as required by Chapter 261, Family Code, for school 10 11 districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and their employees. 12 The policy must provide for cooperation with law enforcement child abuse investigations without the consent of the child's parents if 13 14 necessary, including investigations by the Department of Family and Protective Services. The policy must require each school district 15 16 and open-enrollment charter school employee to report child abuse or neglect, including the trafficking of a child under Section 17 20A.02(a)(5) or (7), Penal Code, in the manner required by Chapter 18 261, Family Code, except that a school district or open-enrollment 19 charter school employee must make the report to both the Department 20 21 of Family and Protective Services and a local or state law enforcement agency. Each school district and open-enrollment 22 charter school shall adopt the policy. 23

SECTION 2. Section 261.103, Family Code, is amended by

1 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
2 follows:

3 (a) Except as <u>otherwise</u> provided by <u>this section</u> 4 [Subsections (b) and (c)] and Section 261.405, a report shall be 5 made to:

6 (1) any local or state law enforcement agency;

(2) the department; or

8 (3) the state agency that operates, licenses, 9 certifies, or registers the facility in which the alleged abuse or 10 neglect occurred.

11 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, an 12 employee of a school district or open-enrollment charter school who 13 is required to make a report of child abuse or neglect, including 14 the trafficking of a child under Section 20A.02(a)(5) or (7), Penal 15 Code, must make a report to both the department and to a local or 16 state law enforcement agency.
