 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the use of automatic license plate readers by a law
 1-22 enforcement agency.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Section 411.0094 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 411.0094. AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READER. (a) In
 1-27 this section, "automatic license plate reader" means a system that
 1-28 reads and records license plate numbers taken from digital
 1-29 photographs.

1-30 (b) A law enforcement agency may use an automatic license
 1-31 plate reader.

1-32 (c) Images and any related data produced from an automatic
 1-33 license plate reader under Subsection (b) may be used only for the
 1-34 following law enforcement purposes:

1-35 (1) investigating a criminal offense; or

1-36 (2) investigating a report of a missing person.

1-37 (d) All images and data produced from an automatic license
 1-38 plate reader under this section shall be destroyed not later than
 1-39 the first anniversary of the date of collection unless the image or
 1-40 data is evidence in a criminal investigation or prosecution.

1-41 (e) The department shall adopt rules as necessary to
 1-42 implement this section.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
