4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 8, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 1461 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 1461. DISCRIMINATION AGAINST PHYSICIAN BASED ON
8	MAINTENANCE OF CERTIFICATION
9	Sec. 1461.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Enrollee" means an individual who is eligible to
11	receive health care services under a managed care plan.
12	(2) "Maintenance of certification" has the meaning
13	assigned by Section 151.002, Occupations Code.
14	(3) "Managed care plan" means a health benefit plan
15	under which medical care services are provided to enrollees through
16	contracts with physicians and that requires enrollees to use
17	participating physicians or that provides a different level of
18	coverage for enrollees who use participating physicians. The term
19	includes a health benefit plan issued by:
20	(A) a health maintenance organization;
21	(B) a preferred provider benefit plan issuer; or
22	(C) any other entity that issues a health benefit
23	plan, including an insurance company.
24	(4) "Participating physician" means a physician who

- 1 has directly or indirectly contracted with a health benefit plan
- 2 issuer to provide services to enrollees.
- 3 (5) "Physician" means a person licensed to practice
- 4 medicine in this state.
- 5 Sec. 1461.002. APPLICABILITY. (a) This chapter applies to
- 6 <u>a physician regardless of whether the physician is a participating</u>
- 7 physician.
- 8 (b) This chapter applies to a person to whom a managed care
- 9 plan issuer contracts to:
- 10 (1) process or pay claims;
- 11 (2) obtain the services of physicians to provide
- 12 medical care services to enrollees; or
- 13 (3) issue verifications or preauthorizations.
- 14 Sec. 1461.003. DISCRIMINATION BASED ON MAINTENANCE OF
- 15 CERTIFICATION. A managed care plan issuer may not differentiate
- 16 between physicians based solely on a physician's maintenance of
- 17 certification in regard to:
- 18 <u>(1) paying the physician;</u>
- 19 (2) reimbursing the physician; or
- 20 (3) directly or indirectly contracting with the
- 21 physician to provide services to enrollees.
- 22 SECTION 2. Section 151.002(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 23 by adding Subdivision (6-b) to read as follows:
- 24 (6-b) "Maintenance of certification" means the
- 25 satisfactory completion of periodic recertification examinations
- 26 required to maintain certification after an initial certification
- 27 <u>under a medical specialty member board, including the member boards</u>

- 1 of the American Board of Medical Specialties or the specialty
- 2 certifying boards of the American Osteopathic Association.
- 3 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 151, Occupations Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Section 151.0515 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 151.0515. DISCRIMINATION BASED ON MAINTENANCE OF
- 6 CERTIFICATION. A hospital, institution, or program that is
- 7 licensed by this state, is operated by this state or a political
- 8 <u>subdivision of this state</u>, or directly or indirectly receives state
- 9 financial assistance may not differentiate between physicians
- 10 based solely on a physician's maintenance of certification.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 155.003, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 12 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 13 follows:
- (d) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), in $[\frac{1}{1}]$ addition
- 15 to the other requirements prescribed by this subtitle, the board
- 16 may require an applicant to comply with other requirements that the
- 17 board considers appropriate.
- 18 <u>(d-1) The board may not require maintenance of</u>
- 19 certification by an applicant for the applicant to be eligible for a
- 20 license under this chapter.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 156.001, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 23 <u>(f) The board may not adopt a rule requiring maintenance of</u>
- 24 certification by a license holder for the license holder to be
- 25 eligible for an initial or renewal registration permit.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
