**IN RE: HB279** by Howard (Relating to the continuation of the women's health advisory committee.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Government Code section 531.02221(e) to continue the women's health advisory committee through September 1, 2019. The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in each house. Otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Based on LBB's analysis of Health and Human Services Commission, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
