HB 1523 Nevárez Relating to the continuation of the regulation of land surveyors and the transfer of the regulation to the Texas Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, following the recommendations of the Sunset Advisory Commission; changing fees.

HB 1962 Lambert / Thompson, Senfronia / Flynn / Paddie / Nevárez Relating to the continuation and functions of the Texas State Library and Archives Commission.

HB 1501 Nevárez Relating to the creation of the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council and to the continuation and transfer of the regulation of psychologists, marriage and family therapists, professional counselors, and social workers to the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council; providing civil and administrative penalties; authorizing a fee.
