Relating to driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses, and other identification certificates; authorizing and increasing fees.

Relating to driver's licensing requirements for minors.

Relating to repealing automatic driver's license suspensions for certain drug offenses.

Relating to a statewide disaster alert system.

Relating to the entry of certain bond conditions into the Texas Crime Information Center.

Relating to requiring a person convicted of an offense involving family violence or a felony or a person who is the subject of a protective order to surrender firearms owned by the person.

Relating to education and training for peace officers regarding trauma-informed techniques to facilitate interactions with homeless individuals.

HB 3138                  Bowers  
Relating to reporting of incidents of sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking on state property.

HB 4469                  Meza  
Relating to the establishment of a grant program and task force relating to disaster issues affecting persons who are elderly and persons with disabilities.

Relating to peace officer instruction on veterans affected by trauma.

Relating to a study conducted by the Department of Public Safety on the investigation and prosecution of sexual assault offenses.

Relating to the compilation and reporting of statistics involving sexual assault victims who receive a forensic medical examination before reporting the assault to law enforcement.

Relating to a policy requiring public and private primary and secondary schools and public junior colleges to provide local law enforcement agencies certain information regarding certain individuals authorized to carry a handgun on a campus.

Relating to the notification of a peace officer through an indication associated with vehicle registration that a person has a health condition that may impede communication.

Relating to the forensic examination of a victim of an alleged
