1-19 relating to the issuance of specialty license plates for retired
1-20 peace officers.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
1-23 is amended by adding Section 504.5111 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 504.5111. RETIRED PEACE OFFICERS. (a) In this
1-25 section, "retired peace officer" means a person who was formerly
1-26 employed as a peace officer, as defined by Section 1.07, Penal Code.

1-27 (b) The department shall design and issue specialty license
1-28 plates for retired peace officers.

1-29 (c) There is no fee for the issuance of the license plates.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
