1-26 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-27 AN ACT

1-28 relating to the purchase of certain goods and services by the
 1-29 Employees Retirement System of Texas.

1-30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-31 SECTION 1. Section 815.103, Government Code, is amended by
 1-32 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

1-33 (h) Notwithstanding any other law, the retirement system
 1-34 has exclusive authority over all aspects of the purchase of goods
 1-35 and services, if the purchase is:

1-36 (1) made using money other than money appropriated
 1-37 from the general revenue fund; and

1-38 (2) related to the operation of home office facilities
 1-39 used in administering the system, including a purchase related to
 1-40 the administration of tenant leases in the facilities.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
