

SENATE BILLS RETURNED FROM HOUSE WITH AMENDMENTS

SJR 34 **Hughes/ et al.** **SP: Frank/ Leach/ et al.**
Proposing a constitutional amendment affirming the rights and responsibilities of parents.

SB 529 **Sparks** **SP: Craddick**
Relating to the entitlement of certain municipalities to receive tax revenue from certain establishments located near a hotel and convention center project.

SB 541 **Kolkhorst/ et al.** **SP: Hull**
Relating to cottage food production operations.

SB 693 **West** **SP: Anchía/ Moody/ et al.**
Relating to notaries public; creating a criminal offense; authorizing a fee.

SB 963 **Hughes/ et al.** **SP: Manuel**
Relating to allowing Medicaid managed care organizations to engage in marketing about the availability of certain private health benefit plan coverage.

SB 1173 **Perry/ et al.** **SP: Spiller/ Leo Wilson/ et al.**
Relating to the amount of an expenditure made by certain political subdivisions for which a competitive procurement method may be required.

SB 1646 **King/ et al.** **SP: Hefner/ Rose/ et al.**
Relating to criminal conduct involving the theft, damage, or destruction of copper or brass or involving the unauthorized possession of certain copper or brass material, to transactions of metal recycling entities involving certain copper or brass material, to training on identifying certain copper or brass material, and to studying the effect of certain regulations on incidents of theft of copper or brass material; creating criminal offenses; increasing criminal penalties; providing an administrative penalty.

SB 1734 **West** **SP: Bhojani/ Button/ et al.**
Relating to status of certain documents or instruments purporting to convey title to or an interest in real property.

SB 1833 **Parker** **SP: Anchía/ Leach/ et al.**
Relating to the use of a social media platform in furtherance of an offense involving the delivery of a controlled substance; increasing criminal penalties.

SB 1968 **Schwertner** **SP: Harless/ King/ et al.**
Relating to the licensing and regulation of certain real estate professionals by the Texas Real Estate Commission.

SB 2544 **Hancock/ et al.** **SP: Morgan**
Relating to eligibility for mediation of certain out-of-network health benefit claims.
