The chair called the meeting to order at 9:43 AM. There being a quorum present, the following business was transacted:

The chair laid out SB 2053 and recognized Senator Hinojosa, in the absence of the author, to explain the bill.

No witnesses registered or testified on the bill.

Senator Hinojosa moved that SB 2053 be reported favorably to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass and be printed. The motion carried with a record vote of 7 ayes, 0 nays, 0 present not voting, and 0 absent.

Senator Hinojosa moved that the bill be recommended for placement on the Local & Uncontested Calendar on April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025; without objection, it was so ordered.

The chair laid out SCR 29 and recognized the author, Senator Blanco, to explain the bill.
