HB 3207 Dean Posting Rule Suspended Relating to the prosecution and punishment of the offense of intoxication assault; increasing a criminal penalty.

SB 535 Huffman Relating to the admissibility of evidence regarding a victim's past sexual behavior in prosecutions of certain trafficking, sexual, or assaultive offenses.

SB 664 Huffman Relating to qualifications, training, removal, and supervision of certain masters, magistrates, referees, associate judges, and hearing officers.

SB 1019 Huffman | et al. Relating to the admissibility of certain hearsay statements in the adjudication of certain sexual or assaultive offenses committed against a child or a person with a disability.

SB 1020 Huffman | et al. Relating to personal bond offices, to the notification provided to a judge regarding tampering with an electronic monitoring device while released on bond or community supervision, and to the availability of certain information regarding a person required to submit to an electronic monitoring program or being supervised by a community supervision and corrections department.

SB 1120 Hinojosa, Juan "Chuy" | et al. Relating to rights of a victim, guardian of a victim, or close relative of a deceased victim in certain criminal cases involving family violence, sexual or assaultive offenses, stalking, or a violation of a protective order or condition of bond.

SB 1537 Zaffirini | et al. Relating to the appointment of an interpreter in a criminal proceeding. SB 1804 Alvarado | et al. Relating to restitution and compensation paid to victims of certain offenses for tattoo removal related to the offense.
