Relating to the Texas Sovereignty Act.

HB 1056 Dorazio | et al.  
Relating to the issuance of gold and silver specie and the establishment of a currency based on gold and silver; authorizing a fee.

HB 1544 Raymond  
Relating to the recovery by this state from the federal government of certain border security expenditures.

HB 1846 Walle  
Relating to the establishment of the Electric Truck Advisory Council.

HB 2001 Meyer  
Relating to increasing the criminal penalties for insider trading and other misuse of official information.

Relating to requirements for certain meteorological evaluation towers.

Relating to the approval of a certificate of convenience and necessity for certain transmission projects.

Relating to the view of the State Capitol.

HB 3157 Darby  
Relating to interim rates charged by electric utilities during a rate suspension period.

HB 3228 Lambert  
Relating to the inclusion of recycling or disposal provisions in certain lease agreements of wind or solar power facilities.

HJR 98 Vasut | et al.  
Applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention under Article V of the United States Constitution for the limited purpose of proposing one or more amendments to the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and to limit the terms of office of federal officials and members of Congress.
