HB 4402 Gámez Posting Rule Suspended Relating to human operators of certain automated motor vehicles.

HB 4924 Canales Posting Rule Suspended Relating to certain electronic documentation for the transfer of a motor vehicle title.

HB 4966 Canales Posting Rule Suspended Relating to the denial of access to the database of dealer-issued license plates maintained by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles.
