SB 9 Huffman | et al.
Relating to the release of defendants on bail, the duties of a magistrate in certain criminal proceedings, and the regulation of charitable bail organizations.

SB 40 Huffman
Relating to the use by a political subdivision of public funds to pay bail bonds.

SB 1047 Huffman
Relating to the release of defendants on bail, the duties of a magistrate in certain criminal proceedings, and the notice provided by peace officers to victims of family violence, stalking, harassment, or terroristic threat.

SJR 1 Huffman
Proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the denial of bail for an illegal alien charged with an offense punishable as a felony.

SJR 5 Huffman
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail under limited circumstances to a person accused of certain violent or sexual offenses or of continuous trafficking of persons.
